Quick User Guide



1

- Open the door by pressing the upper right corner (image A)



2

- Feed the **HDMI-USB** cable through the inlet and connect the cable to the Artome **HDMI** and **ARTOME +** connectors (image B)



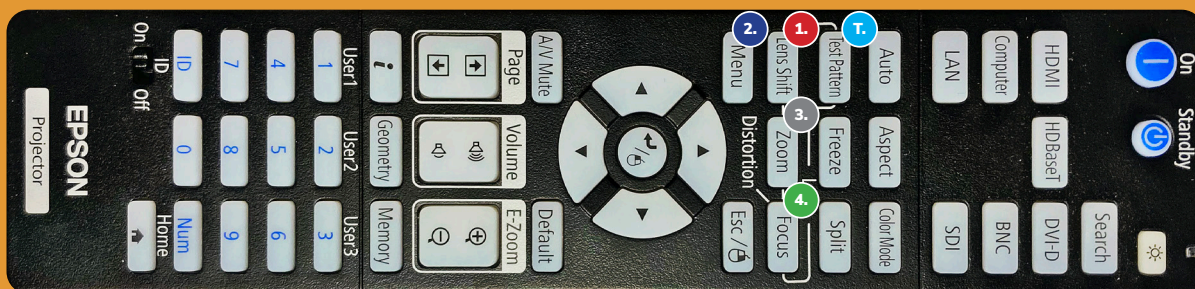

- Connect HDMI-USB cable to your computer HDMI and USB A-ports. Use adapter if necessary. (image C)

4

- Power on the Artome by pressing the **POWER** button on the control panel

Image adjustment



T. Test Pattern

Select the Test Pattern mode and adjust the image with phases 1-4.

1. Lens shift

Adjusts the image position horizontally and vertically

2. Menu / Settings / Geometry Correction / H/V-keystone

V-keystone:

Adjusts the tilt angle of the image
(compare that the vertical edges are straight)

V-balance:

Adjusts the image height
(compare that the circular shapes of the Test Pattern are symmetrical)

3. Zoom

Adjusts the image size

4. Focus

Adjusts the image focus

Control panel



PAUSE

Turns off the image and the sound
 • image and sound restores by pressing again

FREEZE

Freezes the image, but not the sound

VOL +/-

Adjusts the volume

SOURCE

Selects the source between connected devices

POWER

Turns the device on and off

USB

Connection for USB camera

Connections



AUDIO OUT L & R

Audio output for external speakers
 • balanced stereo 0 dBV

MIC 1 & 2

Connection for a wired microphone or a wireless microphone receiver

HDBaseT

Audio and video input

HDMI

Audio and video input

ARTOME+

Interface between video conferencing devices and a computer

USB

Connection for additional devices e.g. a wireless desktop microphone receiver

Power

Connection for the mains power of the device
